## What's the deal?

- Each student in this class has been provided with server space.
- In order to receive credit for homework and projects, they must be uploaded (“published”) to your server space and linked from your index.html page
- You can download Filezilla for free here: <http://filezilla-project.org/>

## What is my website address?

The URL to your web space is:

<http://iam.colum.edu/students/yournetworklogin>

So, if the name you use to log in is “Jonathan Smith”, your URL would look like this:

<http://iam.colum.edu/studetns/jonathan.smith>

The above URL would default to Jonathan’s “index.html” page.

## How do I connect to my server space?

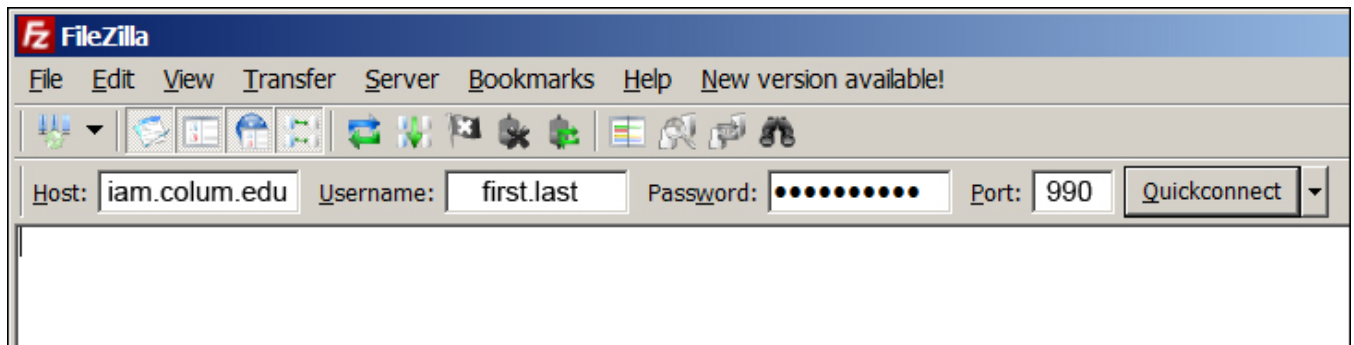
1. Open Filezilla
2. Input the following information at the top:

Host: iam.colum.edu

Username: firstname.lastname

Password: (same as your network password)

Port: 990



3. Click on the QUICKCONNECT button at the right.
4. Drag and drop files into your "pub" folder

## How can I save this info so I don't have to re-type it every time?

1. Open Filezilla
2. Go to File > Site Manager...
3. Click on NEW SITE
4. Give the site a name like "IAM" or "IAM Server"
5. Input the following information:

Host: iam.colum.edu

Port: 990

Protocol: FTP - File Transfer Protocol

Encryption: Require implicit FTP over TLS

Login Type: Normal

- You can set to "Ask for Password" if you don't want it to save your password

Username: firstname.lastname

Password: (same as your network password)
